## Study Circle – Empowering Educators, Enriching Classrooms!

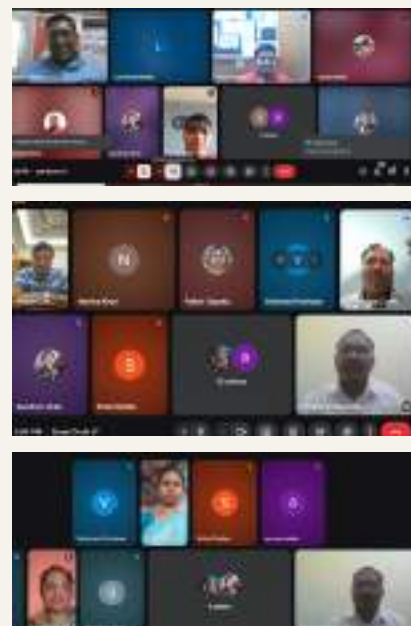
